to H. R. H. the Duke,
to attend the Coronation,
St. James's, Septem^r: 14:
1761.

Our Dearly-beloved Uncle and Counsellor We Greet
you well Whereas the Twenty-second day of this Instant
September is appointed for the Royal Solemnity of Our
and the Queen's Coronation These are to Will and Require
you to make your personal Attendance on Us at the Time
abovementioned furnished and appointed as to your
Rank and Quality appertaineth There to do and perform
such Services as shall be required and belong unto you
Whereof you are not to fail and so we bid you most
heartily farewell

Given at Our Court at St. James's the 14.
Day of September 1761 in the first year of Our
Reign.
