~~Packet~~ Letter to the Master of the Horse  
transmitting Minute relative to the new  
Establishment of his office 12 August 1812

My Lord,

I am commanded by the  
Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury  
to transmit copy of their Lordships Minute  
of the 4<sup>th</sup> inst for your Grace's information, and  
to suggest to your Grace, that in the  
Establishment which you will submit to the  
prince Regent for His Royal Highness's signature,  
it be directed, that, all the aforesaid Salaries,  
and all other Salaries and allowances  
whatsoever payable in the Department of the  
Master of the Horse, should, from the 5<sup>th</sup> day  
of April last, be paid according to their net  
rate or amount, and without any deduction  
in respect of the Land tax and 1.<sup>o</sup> & 6<sup>o</sup> duty,  
and also of the fees of suppressed Offices,  
so that the respective Officers and Servants  
of the Establishment may continue to

receive only the net amount expressed in  
the above Minute, or such as they have  
been heretofore accustomed to receive on account  
of their respective Salaries or allowances.
