That your Petitioner's Father was killed at the Battle of Srirangapatam. his Mother Drowned on his Passage from the east Indies, his Uncle Died some time ago in America Owing to a wound that he received in the breast, And now by the Death of his Aunt your Royal Highness's Petitioner is left without a relation alive, your Petitioner has been in the four quarters of the Globe, with his Father, an Uncle, and should he be ordered to embark, he would be in very distressed circumstances Owing to the Expence of Regimentals, and traveling from the highlands of Scotland.

Your Petitioner therefore most humbly hopes that your Royal Highness will take his deplorable case into consideration and Grant him a Lieutenancy in the Dutch Brigade, York Chasseurs, or any other Regt that your Royal Highness may think proper, and your Petitioner as in duty bound will ever Pray.
