Majesty's Reign a whip  
was provided and sent  
to the Ranger of the  
Curragh of Kildare to  
be run for at the races  
there. Can you give me  
any information as to where  
G. J. Sawers Esq

this whip was purchased,  
what it cost and whether  
it was renewable from  
year to year or not. In  
his late Majesty's Reign  
this whip was, I believe,  
paid for by the Privy
