I am informed his Majesty

to get my wounded knee cured, which

Power to gratify my so long wished
for desire of embracing my
dearest brother, that a joy
once to see you, having been
denied this blessing now 9 years

And happy I shall be if You
will then continue granting me Your
Friendships and brotherly love
which is so dear to me. We have
all reason to expect some attack
in these days, & in that case I
shall still assist. You need
not think this serious, but
only in this manner have I
heard of Mr. Mepher's going
away & could not at the oppor-
tunity slip without informing You
of the same Affair.
